Grape	60 % Blaufränkisch, 40% combine Zweigelt, Merlot & Cabernet Sauvignon
Vineyards & soil	a selection of the best vineyards of Deutschkreutz, gravelly, clayey
Age of vineyards	between 30 and 45 years
Ageing	Hand-harvested. Selected grapes in the vineyard. Fermented with natural yeasts within open fermentation barrels. Manual punch down of the must (Pegeage) and pomp over of the wine (remontage). Malolactic fermentation. Aged for 20 months in new 225 liter oak barrels made of selected French oak.
Analyse	13,5 % alc 5,5 g/l total acidity 3,0 g/l total sugar
Perfect temperature	16°-17°C
