### *Wine Description*

Dark ruby garnet with a deep core and violet reflections. The bouquet impresses with dark, peppery blackberry and cherry notes, hints of wild berries with a touch of nougat, fine herbs and precious wood and a touch of liquorice. Lots of excitement and finesse on the palate. In particular, this top Blaufränkisch is precise, juicy, tight-knit, with a beautiful wild berry cocktail, elegant freshness, enchanting fruit sweetness, mature and silky tannins through to mineral-salty and a long finish with deep fruit play.

### *About In Signo Sagittarii*

In Signo Sagittarii has been around since 2002 and is named after Patrick Bayer's zodiac sign. This one-variety Blaufränkisch was first created by him at the age of 19. What is unique about this Blaufränkisch is the individual touch and individuality of each vintage. The wine thus only lives up to its name - in the sign of Sagittarius. The grapes come from over 70-year-old vineyards on the Neckenmarkter Hochberg. They are among the oldest Blaufränkisch plants in Austria.
